

# INFORMATION SHEET ZUSAMMEN WANDERN

*Zusammen Wandern* is a project from *Solinetz* Zurich. It promotes intercultural exchanges, supports the learning of German language, and enables participants to discover the city of Zurich and surrounding areas. The hikes are coordinated and led by volunteers. *Solinetz* is an independent, non-religious, and non-profit association.

## Program

Hikes take place every Saturday and start at 13:30 at the meeting point of Zurich's central train station (Zurich HB, see image). Depending on the hike, we use public transport (bus, tram, train) to reach the location of the hike. Travel is usually confined to the Zone 110 of the ZVV network of Zurich. The walks are mainly in nearby forest or along lakes and rivers. In case of bad weather, we offer an alternative program, such as a visit to a museum or a cultural event. The hikes take 2-4 hours, and we return to the Zurich train station by latest 17:30. There will be a break for snacks, such as fruits and biscuits, during the hike.

## Who Can Join

The *Zusammen Wandern* walks are suitable for anyone able to hike 2-4 hours at a *normal* pace. Some hikes take place on stony or steep terrain, and therefore *Zusammen Wandern* is not a program suitable for individuals with reduced mobility, nor for small children or baby strollers.

## Tickets for Public Transport

*Solinetz* Zurich covers the public transportation costs of participants from the place of residence to the hike destination and back, primarily within the public transportation network of Zurich (ZVV). Single tickets, 24-hour tickets, 9 o'clock passes, and 6-ride tickets are reimbursed on a pro rata basis. Abonnement are not compensated. Maximum refund: 27CHF per person.

- Dress according to the weather

- Do not take photos of other participants without their consent

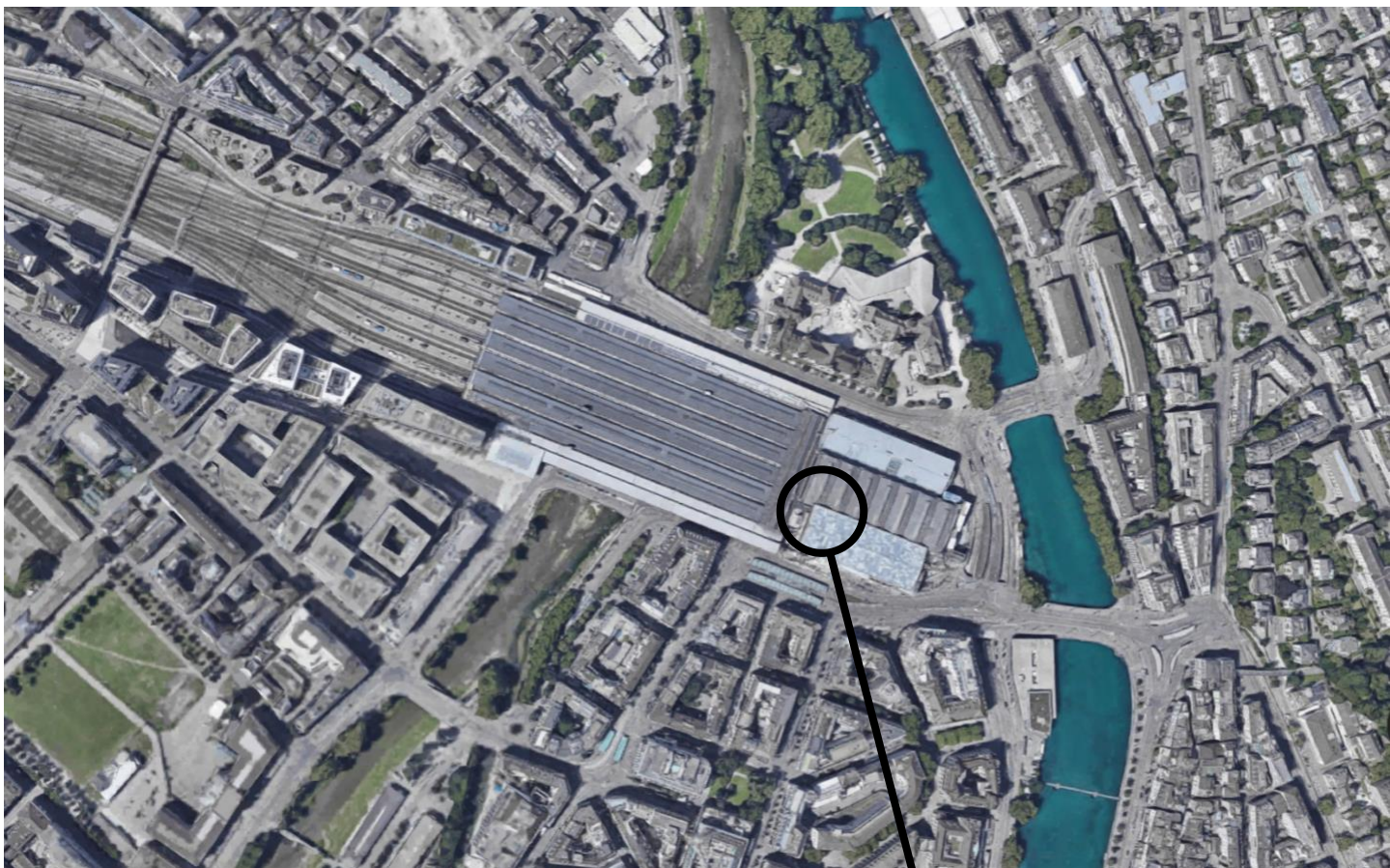
